



Lead Parks Maintenance Technician

Position Summary: Under the general direction of the Parks & Facilities Manager, this position is responsible for assisting in leading the work in the daily field operations and participating in maintaining the Town's parks, grounds, and facilities.

Requirements: High school diploma or equivalent, 4 years of full time increasingly responsible experience in public or private parks, facilities, grounds, or related field, at least eighteen (18) years of age, and possess and maintain valid driver's license

Salary: The expected hiring range is between \$27.21 and \$31.10 per hour, depending on qualifications.
